Dear President,

please allow me to ask you to kindly remit your Association's 2010 membership fee due to the FIEC. The fee for 2010 amounts to 110 Euros (the Euro was adopted by the 2004 General Assembly as the reference currency). Because of bank charges, the payment should be increased by 5% if it is remitted by bank transfer.

The request of membership payment is also available on the FIEC web-site: the address is on the letter-head. I would like to remind you that in all mail and on any international postal order, *my name must obligatorily appear* in the address: the name of the Federation is not sufficient. I would be glad if you could settle payment by any of the following means:

- either by bank transfer made payable to Ac. N° 435738, holder "FRANCO MONTANARI - FIEC", at the bank Cassa di Risparmio di Lucca Pisa Livorno - Sede di Pisa - Piazza Dante - 56126 Pisa - Italy (BIC SWIFT: BPAL IT3L - IBAN: IT 03 W 06200 14011 000000435738). The transaction should mention "2010 membership dues" followed by *the (abbreviated) name of your Association*;

- or by sending a cheque payable at an Italian bank (mentioning *my full name followed by FIEC*), to my home address: "Prof. Franco Montanari - Via San Luca 8 - 56011 Calci (PI) - Italy";

- or by sending an international postal order, made out to my name, to my home address as listed above: please, give *my full name and home address*, and mention "2010 membership dues" as well as *the name of your Association*.

I am confident that you will be interested to learn that an important portion of your membership fees is devoted to supporting projects of general interest such as the *Année Philologique*, the *Thesaurus Linguae Latinae*, the *Supplementum Epigraphicum Graecum* as well as our Congresses and our own dues to the "Conseil International de la Philosophie et des Sciences Humaines" (CIPSH), of which we are active members. This organism is our intermediary for obtaining UNESCO support of the numerous projects and meetings that directly or indirectly concern FIEC member Associations.
